MARYBOROUGH GOLF CLUB COMPETITION CONDITIONS

- 1. Entries close on Wednesday 1st November.
- 2. Players must be prepared to play when called upon by the Committee.
- 3. In every event, competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such a manner as the Committee may arrange. Grades for all events will be allocated at the discretion of the Committee.
- 4. Entries are restricted to amateurs who are Members of Registered Golf Clubs and hold a current Australian Golf Handicap. The Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 5. All competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the Course. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge whose decision shall be final, provided, however, that the Committee, if in doubt, shall have to refer such dispute to the council of the Victoria Golf Association, whose decision shall be final.
- 6. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided by a play-off in the 27 hole (scratch) events, holes 10 & 18 sudden death and repeated if necessary. A count back process will decide all other events.
- 7. Maximum Handicap in all Men's events is 36 (Except events 4, 5, 6 & 7 where it is 27). Maximum handicap in all Women's events is 45.
- 8. The Committee may, in the event of bad weather or any other reason, either shorten any contest or cancel the day's play, and in the case of ties, shall decide the manner in which they shall be determined.
- 9. It is the entrant's responsibility to nominate the partner in four-ball events.
- 10. A maximum of one major trophy is allowed per player or pair per event.
- 11. ALL PLAYERS MUST REPORT TO THE TEE STEWARD AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE TEE OFF TIME. LATE ARRIVALS MAY BE PENALISED.
